### HIGHLAND BRIDGE

The 122-acre site of the former Ford auto plant is one of the greatest urban redevelopment opportunities in generations. After more than a decade of planning with the community, the project will create a connected and livable mixed-use neighborhood with clean technologies, public green space, and a range of housing options. Highland Bridge will contribute significantly to the regional economy with the new value estimated to be over \$1 billion, making this one of the largest private real estate investments in Saint Paul's history. ### **SNELLING-MIDWAY**

The historic Midway neighborhood in Saint Paul is a vibrant, diverse community anchored by light rail service and located in between the two metros. Building on the momentum of Alliance Field, the new home to professional soccer club Minnesota United FC, the intersection of Snelling-Midway is a significant development opportunity for 34 acres of mixed-use commercial, retail and residential spaces in an already-growing central hub.

### **SEARS SITE**

# **RIVERCENTRE OPPORTUNITY**

A premier riverfront site on the bluffs of the Mississippi in downtown Saint Paul, a new 3.4-acre development opportunity is available above the RiverCentre parking ramp and adjacent lands.



### RIVERSEDGE

The ambitious \$788 million redevelopment project along Saint Paul's downtown riverfront will transform how residents, visitors and workers connect to the Mississippi River. In addition to plans for a hotel, luxury housing, retail and Class A office space, the River Balcony will connect the public to Saint Paul's signature natural resource.
